Dear Parents and Guardians,

I want to inform you of an incident that occurred on Sunday, April 26, 2015 at approximately 3:30 p.m. As a male student was walking in the alley south of 26th Street (between Millard and Lawndale Avenues) towards 27th Street, he was approached by a Spanish speaking man who made an indecent solicitation.

The man is described as a fair skin Hispanic who spoke with an accent, between the ages of 28-30 years old, has very short, dark hair, a skinny build and is around 5 feet 5 inches tall. The suspect was last seen wearing a red and black Michael Jordan sweater and jeans.

The police and FBI are aware of this incident and will be patrolling the area of hopes of finding this man. Again, we urge you to remind your children of these steps they can take to help keep them safe:

- Do NOT walk in alleys
- Avoid speaking to strangers
- Be aware of who is around them
- Walk to and from school in groups and stay on the main streets when possible
- Go directly home after school
- Report any suspicious people or activity to an adult or the police.

Your child's safety is our top priority.

Estimados padres y tutores legales,

A través de esta nota les informo de un incidente que ocurrió aproximadamente a las 3:30 de la tarde el domingo, 26 de abril del 2015. Mientras un estudiante caminaba por el callejón al sur de la calle 26 (entre las avenidas de Millard y Lawndale), un hombre de raza Hispano se le acercó y le hizo una propuesta indecente.

La persona en cuestión se describe como hispano de tez blanca, que habla con acento, entre las edades 28 a 30 años, con cabello corto y color oscuro, delgado y mide aproximadamente 5'5 pies. Vestía una sudadera rojo y negra con el logo de Michael Jordán y tenía puesto pantalones de mezclilla.

La policía y el FBI están informados del incidente y estarán patrullando el área. De nuevo tomen las siguientes recomendaciones:

- Nunca caminar por un callejón
- Evite hablar con extraños
- Ser consciente de su alrededor
- Caminar a la escuela en grupos cuando sea posible
- Ir directamente a la casa después de la escuela
- Avisar de cualquier actividad o persona sospechosa a un adulto.

La seguridad de sus hijos es nuestra prioridad.
